EXTRACT OF RULES & REGULATIONS

A. The Membership shall consist of:

- 1) Life Members
- 2) Associate Members
- 3) Youth Members

B. A Philatelist, who is resident in north-east India, shall be eligible to be a Life Member of the Society on payment of a consolidated membership fee of Rs. 2000 (Rs.4000 in case of outside the NE region) payable with the application for membership. The applicant will also be required to pay Rs.100/- as one time Registration Fee.

C. Any person, who is resident in north-eastern India, interested in the art and science of philately shall be entitled to become an Associate Member on payment of an one time Registration Fee of Rs. 100 and an annual subscription of Rs. 300 per annum (Rs.600 in case of outside the NE region), which will be payable in advance. An Associate Membership will cease automatically on being in arrears of subscription or other dues for more than months.

D. Any young philatelist, not more than 18 years of age at the time of application, who is resident in north-eastern India, shall be entitled to become a Youth Member on payment of an one time Registration Fee of Rs. 100 and an annual subscription of Rs. 100 per annum (Rs.200 in case of outside the NE region), which will be payable in advance. A Youth Membership will cease automatically on being in arrears of subscription or other dues for more than months.

E. Admission to membership shall be by application in the Prescribed Form submitted to the Treasurer, subject to the applicable rules, verification and approval by the Governing Council which shall have the right to accept or reject the same.

F. Any member guilty, in the opinion of the governing council of any misconduct, pertaining to philately, which is derogatory to his position as a member of the Society, is liable to suspension or expulsion by a three quarters majority vote of the Governing Council. However, the expulsion shall be done only after giving the concerned member a show-cause notice in writing and providing him a reasonable opportunity to represent his case in defence.

G. A member is entitled to resign his membership, provided he has paid all his dues up to date.

H. Notwithstanding any other provisions of the Rules and Regulations, a member is liable to be expelled by a majority vote of the Governing Council, without prejudice to any rights of the Society, if he is in arrears of subscription or other dues for more than one year.

I. The resignation or termination of a membership, for any reasons whatsoever, shall be without prejudice to the rights of the Society against the member in respect of his obligations to the Society prior to his ceasing to be a member.

J. The membership year of the Society shall be from 1st January to 31st December of the same year.

K. Any amount paid towards admission fee, membership fee, subscription or any instalments thereof shall not be refundable after the acceptance of a membership by the Society, on resignation or termination of the membership for any reasons whatsoever.

L. A member, who is in arrears of subscription, shall lose all his membership privileges, till he clears the arrears.

Registration will expire after 6 months of expiration of membership and members with subscription arrears of more than 6 months will require re-registration.

M. The rights and privileges of a member shall be personal and not transferable.

Note: The above Membership fees and subscriptions are subject to change.
